What a year 2021 was. Despite decades of efforts, all women, and particularly Black and Brown women, faced wage, wealth, and health gaps that persist because of the systems we have place. COVID-19 and the resulting "she-cession" led to an economic crisis that shined a spotlight on these gender and racial gaps.

Women's Fund of Rhode Island's mission is to achieve gender equity through systemic change. Our work is driven by our vision statement, which imagines a community, nation, and world free of gender and racial bias and where social justice exists for all. Our advocacy work, largely successful at the state level, focused on women's economic security and reproductive health access, while continuing to fight for expansions to civic participation and representation.

We celebrated our 20th anniversary through a virtual Women Leading Change Celebration. The event was bittersweet as we honored and remembered our founder, Simone Joyaux, who passed earlier in the year. We continue to fight for the social justice ideals she set forth when she launched Women's Fund of Rhode Island and invite you to do the same.

2021 AT A GLANCE

WFRI trained **1,000 people** to advocate for themselves and their community through our #lamRemarkable, Salary Negotiation and Advocacy 101 workshops.

In August, we partnered with VoteRunLead to train **45 women** to run for office. The "Run As You Are" session showed women how to translate their passion, experiences, and drive into political power. Of those, **13** are running for office and **25** indicated that they planned to run for office in the future.

WFRI welcomed **15** new fellows to our Women's Policy Institute. Together with community advocates, they worked to pass the Perinatal Doula Health Insurance Coverage Age. They also supported the work of the previous cohort by working on Preventing Source of Housing Income Discrimination.
