We helped to pass the Equality in Abortion Coverage Act (EACA).

We helped codify the Affordable Care Act's protections banning co-copays for birth control and ensuring coverage for pre-existing conditions.

We supported the efforts to secure \$7M in the state's budget for preventing Pre-K classroom closures.

We passed a bill allowing pharmacists to prescribe birth control.
