Blogging tips and guidelines

Writing on an audience-centric site like the Women's Fund blog is different than writing for your own personal blog. You will be writing for a community of readers for social change and gender equality looking for ideas and inspiration. For this reason, we are looking for specific types of posts:

- Posts that are interesting and relevant to social change
- Photographs related to posts and the mission of the Women's Fund (images must comply with copyright laws)
- Research about ways to turn Rhode Island into an equitable state

We are looking for dedicated bloggers to join our volunteer-based blog team and advocate for women and girls in our state. Please know that the blog team is uncompensated. However, writing for an audience-focused blog can be very rewarding as it gives you a chance to further issues you care about.
